

Conditions for admission to the follow-up Master's studies at the Faculty of AgriSciences at Mendel University in Brno in the academic year 2022/2023 the second round

§ 1 Introductory provisions

- (1) The conditions for admission to the Master's programmes (hereinafter referred to as "conditions for admission") at the Faculty of AgriSciences at Mendel University in Brno (hereinafter just "the university") are determined in accordance with provisions of Sections 48 to 50 of Act No. 111/1998 Coll., on higher education institutions and on the amendment and supplement of other acts as later amended (the Higher Education Act), relevant provisions of the Statutes of Mendel University in Brno and the relevant provisions of the Study and Examination Regulations of Mendel University in Brno.
- (2) The conditions for admission are disclosed in accordance with Section 49 (5) and (6) of the Higher Education Act.

§ 2 Study programmes/specialisations and the anticipated numbers of students enrolled to study

1) The admissions process for study at the Faculty of AgriSciences at Mendel University in Brno in academic year 2022/2023 (hereinafter referred to as "FA MENDELU") will be held in the study programme listed hereunder.

§ 3 Submission of applications to study and admissions procedure fee

- (1) The application for study is submitted electronically. The application must first be completed electronically using the University Information System of Mendel University in Brno (hereinafter referred to as the "Information System"), then printed and sent in hard copy to the Study Department of the Dean's Office by **August 10**, **2022**, preferably by registered post.
- (2) Documents that must be submitted with the application to the study department of the Faculty of AgriSciences:
 - Copy of the Bachelor's Diploma
 - List of completed courses (Transcript of records)
- (3) The form for completing the electronic part of the application for study is available at https://is.mendelu.cz/prihlaska/.
- (4) The applicant shall fill in the section "Personal data" and the section "Address". If the data are properly entered, the sections in the information system will be marked as complete.
- (5) The completed application in the information system must be printed and signed by the applicant. The applicant confirms the veracity of all the above-mentioned data by attaching his/her signature to the application. The information contained in the information system and in the paper form of the application must be identical.
- (6) There is no fee for the admission process to the follow-up Master's degree programme in English.



- (7) The application will be included in the admission procedure if all sections of the application in the information system are marked as complete following the delivery of the hard copy of the application to the Study Department of the Dean's Office, and after all data have been checked by the study officer.
- (8) Deficiencies in the application completed in the information system and in the paper application sent with all the requirements to the study department are eliminated by the applicant for study on the basis of a call and instructions from the Study Department of the Dean's Office of the Faculty of AgriSciences. Failure to duly and timely remedy the deficiencies may result in discontinuing the admission procedure.
- (9) An applicant who has received an education abroad with the exception of the Slovak Republic and has fulfilled the conditions of the admission procedure is obliged to deliver a certified copy of the nostrification decision.

§ 4

The conditions for admission to follow-up Master's studies conducted in a foreign language

- (1) The condition for admission to study in the follow-up Master's degree programme is the proper completion of studies in a Bachelor's or Master's degree programme pursuant to Section 48 (5) of the Higher Education Institutions Act.
- (2) A compulsory part of the admission procedure is the entrance examination. The entrance examination takes the form of a written test from the subjects of the state final examination of the previous Bachelor's studies at the FA MENDELU. The ranking of applicants, compiled on the basis of the total number of points achieved, is an essential basis for admission.
- (3) The test consists of 30 questions, each question having 4 alternatives, only one of which is correct.
- (4) Dean has the right to determine the scope and method of the entrance examination and to assess the qualifications of applicants according to the additional documents sent.
- (5) There is a charge for studying in a study programme conducted in a foreign language. The amount of the fees is set out in the Rector's Regulation "Fees related to the study and fees for acts related to habilitation and procedure for the appointment of a professor".

§ 5 Final provisions

- (1) The applicant only settles any administrative issues related to the admissions procedure with the Study Department of the Dean's Office of the Faculty of AgriSciences.
- (2) In the case of entrance examinations held abroad, the Dean may set slightly different dates for the individual steps and conditions of the admission procedure.
- (3) Report on the course of the admission procedure pursuant to Section 50 (9) of the Higher Education Act will be published by the Faculty of AgriSciences on www.af.mendelu.cz.
