

Admission Results for the First Year of Doctoral Study Programmes Taught in English at the Faculty of AgriSciences, Mendel University in Brno, Academic Year 2026/2027 For applicants who obtained their Master's degree outside the Czech Republic

➤ Admitted applicants

The notification of admission has been published in the applicant's electronic application in the **Document storage** section.

A **Confirmation of Admission** for the purpose of obtaining a long-term visa/residence permit in the Czech Republic will be sent by registered mail after the applicant's Master's degree has been successfully assessed. The official **Decision on Admission** will be handed over to the applicant during study enrolment upon presentation of a certified copy of the Master's diploma.

Applicants who obtained their Master's degree outside the Czech Republic (with the exception of the Slovak Republic) must also present one of the following documents at study enrolment:

1. a positive assessment of the applicant's foreign higher education for the purposes of the admission procedure under the Rector's Directive No. 12/2022;

or

2. a certified copy of the Czech recognition certificate (*nostrification*) confirming recognition of higher education in the Czech Republic, together with a certified copy of the foreign diploma and its official translation prepared by a certified (sworn) translator.

Detailed information has been sent to all admitted applicants by email.

➤ Non-admitted applicants

The **Decision on Non-Admission** has been sent by registered mail to the correspondence address provided in the electronic application.

An appeal against the Decision on Non-Admission must be submitted separately for each study programme via the Contact Centre application using **005_PR_AF – Appeal against the Decision on Non-Admission to Study**.

After submitting the appeal electronically, the applicant must print and sign the form and deliver it to the Study Department of the Faculty within seven calendar days, together with a certified copy of the Master's diploma.

This requirement does not apply to graduates of Master's degree programmes completed at the Faculty of AgriSciences, Mendel University in Brno, as their education and graduation documents are already recorded in the University's information system. Please submit the appeal only after you have received the written Decision on Non-Admission by post.

Current information will be published regularly on the Faculty website of the Study Department.
