

Health restrictions for studies in bachelor and consecutive master degree programmes



Applicant category	Health restrictions
Applicant with an visual impairment	A severe visual impairment that, even with the use of assistive devices, does not allow for the safe performance of laboratory and practical exercises, the handling of animals, and/or navigation within operational areas.
Applicant with a hearing impairment	A severe hearing impairment that, even with the use of assistive devices, does not allow for safe communication while working in the laboratory and with animals.
Applicant with a limitation of mobility	A severe limitation of mobility in the upper or lower limbs that makes it impossible to perform basic laboratory and practical tasks, handle animals, or ensure one's own safety.
Applicant with specific medical conditions	Diseases, conditions, and impairments listed in Decree No. 271/2012 Coll. that constitute a contraindication for work in a laboratory and with animals.

The above health restrictions are based on the need to ensure the safety of the student, classmates, and animals during practical training. During the course of study, work in chemical, biological, and technical laboratories—as well as work with live animals and products of animal origin—is expected.
